The competitions covered by this rule book, including Area Competitions for the following Championships, are: SUMMER SEASON COMPETITIONS Horse Trials Championships 2009 National Championships 2009 DTM & Quadrille 2009 WINTER SEASON COMPETITIONS Novice Indoor Show Jumping 2010 Winter Dressage 2010 Festival of the Hunter 2010
5	G2.3	The appropriate number of reserves should also be shown on the Championship Entry Form Delete this entry
5	G3.3	G3.3: Summer Season Competitions
5	G3.4	G3.4: Winter Season Competitions
6	G5.1	A rider may change clubs between competition seasons (see G1.3, G3.3 and G3.4) but they must remain with their new club for a minimum of 12 months from that change date.
6	G5.2	ChanQe aQe to 18 on 1 January
7	G6.4	G6.4: Mares in foal Mares must not compete after their fourth month of pregnancy or with foal at foot.
7	G7.1	After the course of injections include - Only the first two injections need to have been given before the horse may compete.
10	G11	G11.2: Pairs Reserves One reserve is allowed for any pairs competition, dressage, dressage to music or FOTH ChallenQe
10	G11	G11.3: Individual Reserves
10	G11	G11.4: Eligibility of Reserves All nominated reserves must be eligible for the competition that they are entered for and must have been an affiliated member of their club at the close of preliminary entries for that competition.
13	G17.4	G17.4: Riders It is forbidden for any rider to compete whilst under the influence of any stimulating, calming or other drug or substance as detailed in the British Equestrian Federation Rules. The BEF and member bodies are signatories to the World Anti Doping Code.

22	01.11	Elementary & Pairs List 1 to 5 DTM & pairs DTM List 1 to 5
24	01.12.6	If a horse/pony and/or rider falls during the test the competitor will be eliminated

34	SJ 1 .4	The top pole of any fence, should, where possible, be wooden
35	SJ1.8.3	In the event of equality for <i>qualifying</i> places ...

87	Appendix 5	Market Harborough's are permitted (<i>Juniors and seniors</i>) but not in combination with any other martingale.
